



EMMA JOHANSSON WINS HER SIXTH SWEDISH ROAD RACE CHAMPIONSHIP

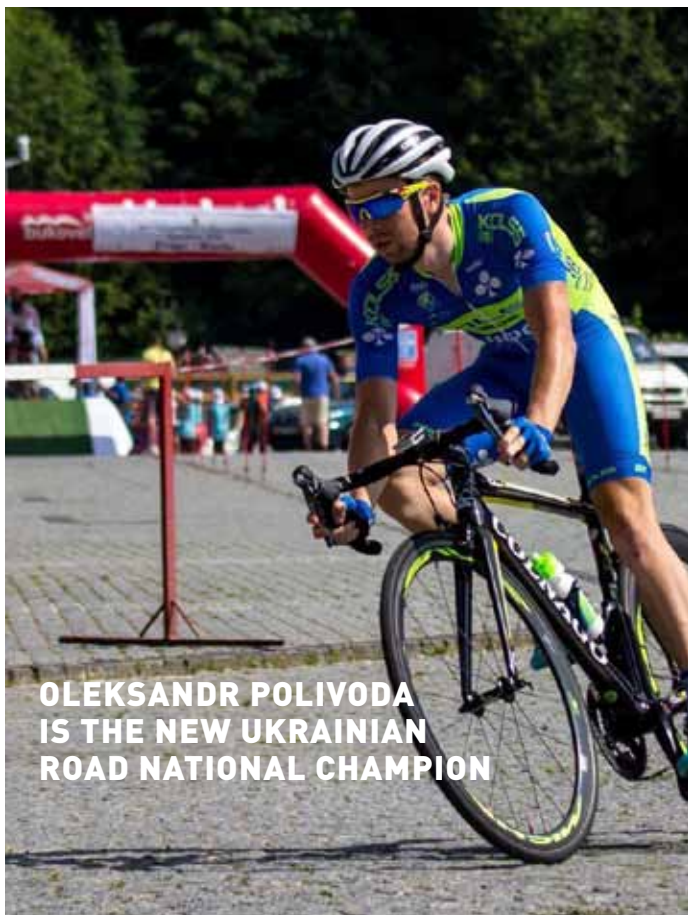
Wiggle High5 Pro Cycling's Emma Johansson successfully defended her Swedish National Road Race Championship, taking her sixth career title in Västerås, on the western side of Sweden. The 32-year-old soloed clear of the peloton with just over a quarter of the 120km race remaining, to finish an incredible four minutes, 28 seconds clear of the sprint for second place; won by Sara Mustonen (Liv-Plantur), ahead of former black and orange rider Emilia Fahlin (Alé-Cipollini).



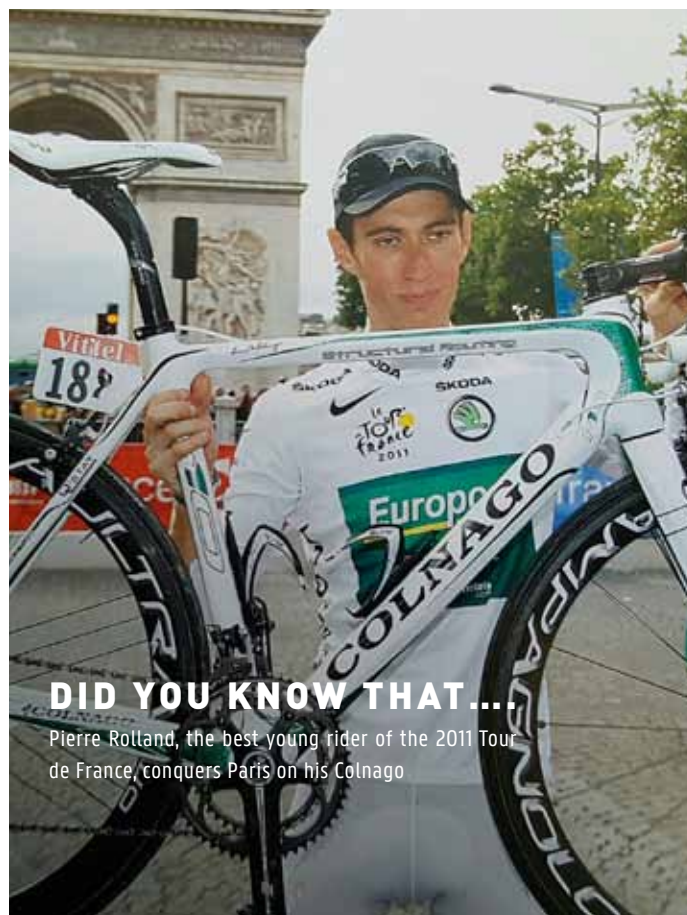


FOUR ITT CHAMPIONS FOR WIGGLE HIGH 5 PRO CYCLING

Wiggle High5 Pro Cycling's Elisa Longo Borghini and Emma Johansson have both taken their National Individual Time Trial Championships in Italy and Sweden respectively. Longo Borghini regained the title that she won in 2014, but missed the defence of last year through illness, while Johansson's was her fifth consecutive title, and eighth in all. Audrey Cordon-Ragot and Anna Sanchis have added two more National Time Trial Championships to the black and orange roster, as both riders retained the French and Spanish titles that they took last year.

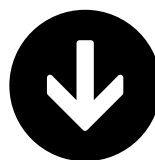
