



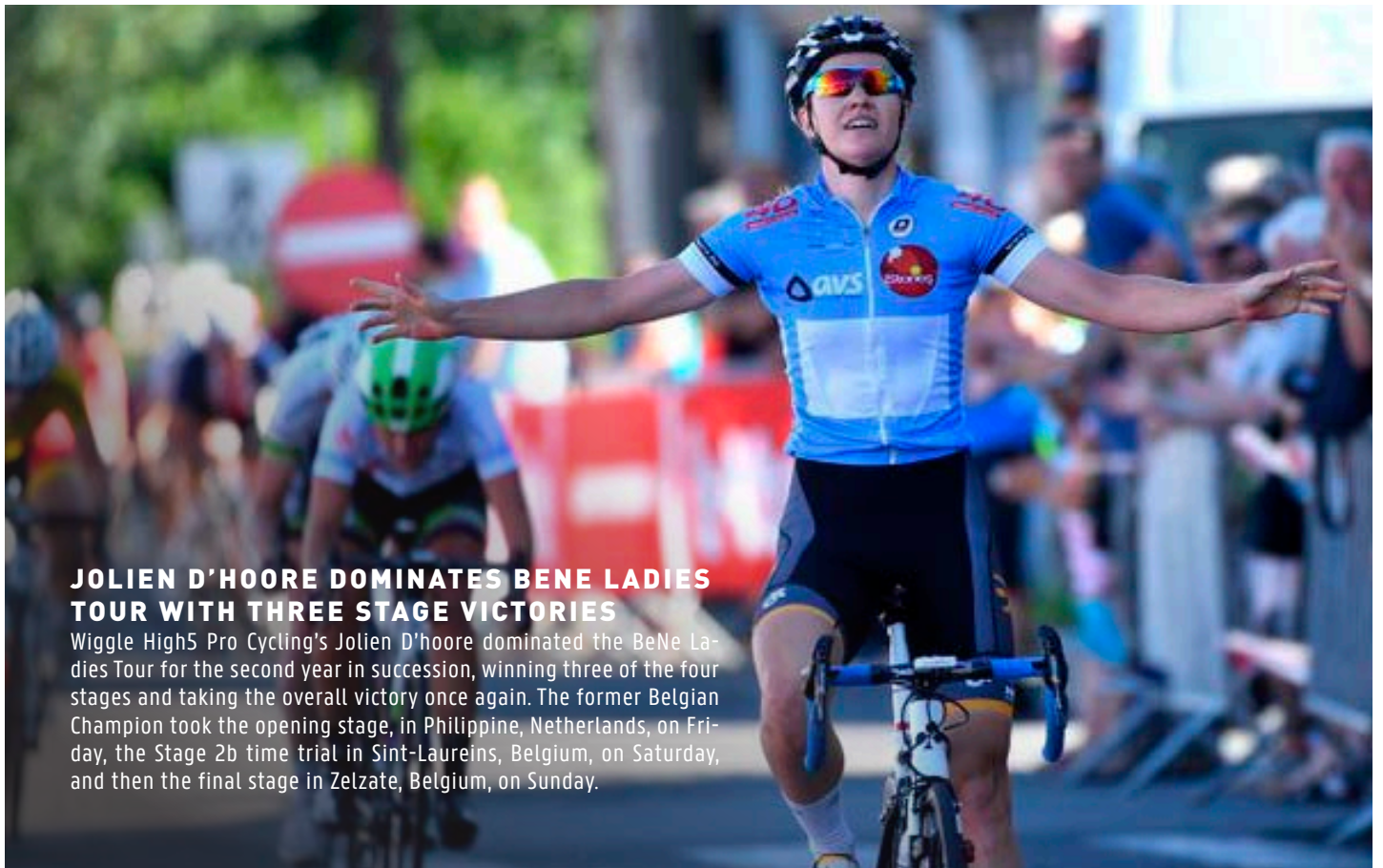
TODAY IS THE COLNAGO C-RS LAUNCH DAY
