Giorgia Bronzini third in aggressive Tour de Yorkshire race

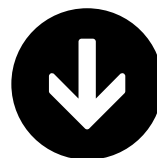
Wiggle High5 Pro Cycling's Giorgia Bronzini took third place in the Asda Women's Tour de Yorkshire, between Tadcaster and Harrogate. The former two-time road World Champion finished second in the small bunch sprint at the end of an aggressive, hilly, 122km race, behind American Coryn Rivera (Sunweb), 55 seconds behind winner Lizzie Armitstead (Boels-Dolmans) who was the sole remaining rider from the mid-race breakaway.
