Capetonians take top spots in the men's race

SOUTH African cyclists enjoyed optimum conditions as they won the Cape Town Cycle Tour, winning the men's and women's races, with all Top 3 positions going to Cape Towners.

Lead cyclist Clint Hendricks and Benji RoadCover from Proteas were crowned winners of the world's largest annual cycle race.

Following the Proteas' Hendricks, originally from Pieter, regional giant Dimension Data Continental's Jayde Julius and two-time defending champion Nolan Hoffman (Team Telkom) were also in the top three.

Hendricks said for the men's race the Dimension Data team would take the lead. "The men's race started in the same hazy, hazy conditions as the Proteas race were a strong team of 12 riders, essentially attacking on the right and centre."

"I could have done it without any team," he said.

Second-placed Julius expressed disappointment with his placing, after having won it twice in previous years. "Hendricks and RoadCover were really strong and I think they were a bit better than I was."

Julius said he was happy to be in the top three and that he would be back in the Cape Town Cycle Tour next year.
