Team Novo Nordisk Unveils New Kit and Roster



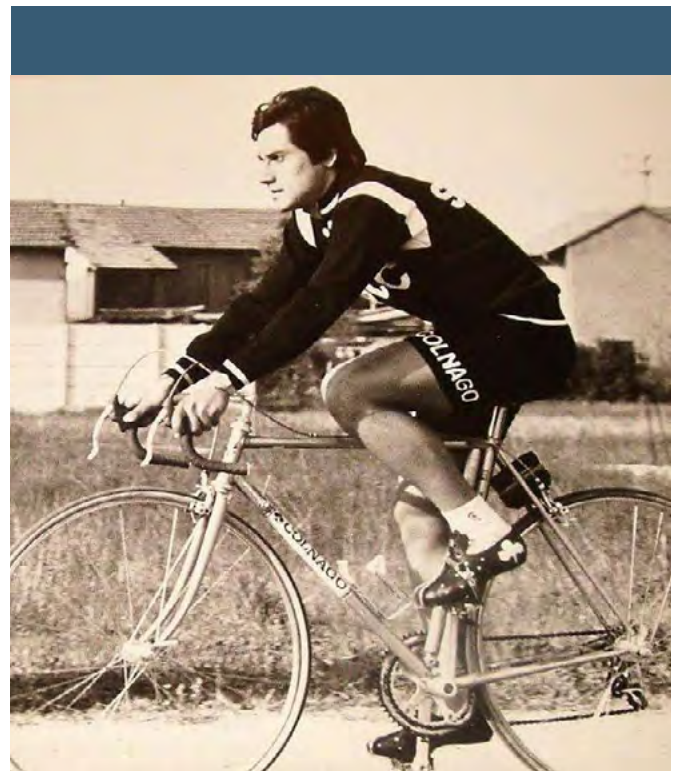

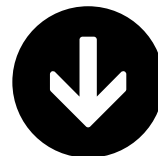
